REHEARSAL/ANNUAL EXAMINATION/GRADES FOR THE SESSION 2020-2021 (11/02/2021)

Students and parents are hereby notified that the Rehearsal Examination-Theory portion for Classes X & XII and Annual Examination/Grades for Classes I-IX and XI shall be held as per the timetables appended with this Notice. In this context please note the following important information:

<u>Venue/Platform</u>: The **Annual Examination** shall be held on the Zoom Platform for all the classes but **Rehearsal Exam for Classes X and XII** shall be conducted in the school premises.

<u>Format & Duration</u>: Class IX-XII – The theory papers for each subject shall be held in **one session** and on the same day. Class IX and Class XI shall have subject wise newly introduced Interactive Viva Exams along with the theory papers. Students need to appear for Viva compulsorily in order to appear in the Annual Examination. A detailed schedule for the viva shall be published at the earliest.

<u>Classes IV-VIII</u>: The exam for each subject shall be held in **two parts** on the same day. Please refer to the timetable appended for duration and timing details.

Syllabus: Teachers are circulating the applicable syllabus through the WhatsApp groups.

Marks Allotment:

<u>Class IV-VIII</u>: Two papers of 25 marks which will be scaled up to 80. Remaining 20 marks to be evaluated through the projects.

<u>Class IX and XI</u>: One Theory paper of 70/80 marks for each subject. Remaining 30/20 marks to be evaluated through the projects. 20% weightage has been demarcated for online interactive Viva based Exam and written portion of the said paper shall contain 80% weightage.

<u>Class X and XII</u>: One Theory paper of 70/80 marks for each subject. Remaining 30/20 marks to be evaluated through the Practicals and projects.

Students, Parents and Guardians to follow the prevalent rules & regulations and refrain from providing any help to the student during the online exam. If the student is caught cheating, the paper will be cancelled and 'Zero' marks will be awarded. Adequate network facilities with backup has to be provided to the candidates to ensure timely completion of the Tests.

In the event of any hiccups/unforeseen circumstances the school authorities will resolve by taking appropriate measures as deemed fit to make it a successful event.

Cooperation of all concerned is solicited and expected.
