IMPORTANT MATTERS PERTAINING TO ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-23

1. By the grace of God, the pandemic stage of COVID-19 seems to be coming to an end. The state government has now almost fully opened schools and we are gradually returning to normalcy in our lives. We thank the parents & students and the staff at St. Francis Xavier School for their overwhelming cooperation during these testing time. As we make a fresh start in the new academic session, parents and guardians are notified as follows.
2. The existing **discounted fee structure shall lapse on the 15th of March 2022** and not be available from new academic session. The fee structure applicable for existing students in the new session is appended below:

3. Classes will be held in the format (Online/Offline/HYBRID) as per the orders of the Govt. of West Bengal issued from time to time.
4. It shall be assumed that those continuing in the new session are agreeable to aforesaid fee structure and the other rules and regulations mentioned herein and those mentioned in the school diary and fee books. Annual/Session Fees and the First Quarter Fees for the Academic Session 2022-23 must be cleared by the **15th of April 2022**. Defaulters may not be allowed to continue with classes thereafter.
5. Total dues up to the Academic Session 2021-22 should be cleared by the Open House date else results will be withheld. To join classes in the new academic session, all previous dues must be cleared.
6. From 1st April 2022 onwards Fees to be paid either at the Bank (Cash/DD) or through the school website or PAYTM portal. Henceforth, fees **SHOULD NOT** be paid through payment apps or through bank transfer as it leads to reconciliation problems and wastage of time. A processing charge of Rs. 500/- per transaction will be imposed if any fees are paid vide payment apps or through bank transfer in the new session.
7. The above is issued keeping in view the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court vide an order passed in a PIL before it.
