NOTICE STUDENTS OF CLASSES IV TO XII INTER-HOUSE BADMINTON TOURNAMENT 2025-26

Students of Classes IV to XII are hereby informed that the school is organizing The Inter-House Badminton Competition from Classes IV to XII on 21st January, 2026.

There will be four categories in the tournament :

Group A : Girls of classes IV-V

Group B : Girls of classes VI-VIII

Group C : Girls of classes IX-XII

Group D : Boys of classes IX-XII

Girls of Classes IV to V will have their Semi Final and Final Rounds at the the School premises from 08:30 am onwards.

Classes IX to XII will be having their matches at the Spuddy Badminton Academy, Kadapara, beside Apollo Hospitals on 21st of January, 2026 from 10:00 am onwards.

Reporting time for the selected students of Classes VI to X on 21st January'2026 will be 09:00 am.

The following are the rules and regulations of the matches :

- A match consists of the best of 3 games of 11 points.
- Every time there is a serve – there is a point scored.
- The side winning a rally adds a point to its score.
- At 10 all, the side which gains a 2 point lead first, wins that game.
- At 18 all, the side scoring the 19th point, wins that game.
- The side winning a game serves first in the next game.
- At the beginning of the game (0-0) and when the server's score is even, the server serves from the right service court. When the server's score is odd, the server serves from the left service court.
- If the server wins a rally, the server scores a point and then serves again from the alternate service court.
- If the receiver wins a rally, the receiver scores a point and becomes the new server. They serve from the appropriate service court – left if their score is odd, and right if it is even.

The students must come in proper PT T-shirt, divided skirt or white shorts with tights (knee level) for girls and white shorts for boys, clean white keds or badminton shoes (properly cleaned soles and white socks).

Students of Classes XI and XII shall disperse for home directly from the venue after the event, while classes VI to X will return to school for normal classes. Students of Classes IV and V will be having normal dipersal.

Badminton Racquets and shuttlecocks will be provided by the school, however students can bring their own racquets. Light refreshments will be provided to all the students.
